Paonia Parent Organization (PPO)

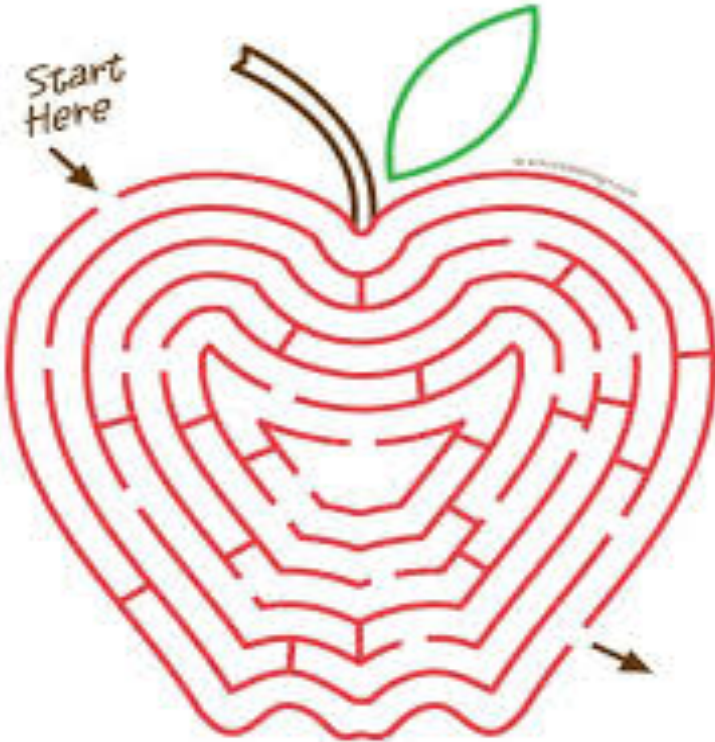
