Please let me know how I can help! I am a great alarm clock.

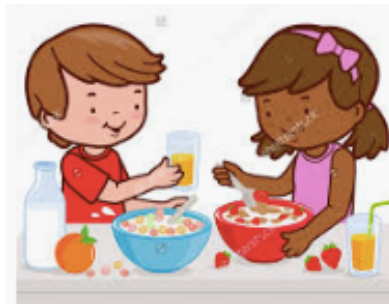
