We had a fun day on Halloween! Besides having a party at the end of the day, we walked to the public library for a story and also sang at Paonia Care Center.

We are continuing to get together with Mrs. Simpson's second grade class every week to collaborate with writing and reading. This has been so beneficial to both groups of kids.

We are studying about the Pilgrims and what life was like for them after they sailed to America. We will be making books, pies, rolls and butter.

We will perform a short program about the first Thanksgiving on Friday, November 17th, at 2:45 on the stage by the preschool. Parents and family members are invited. Afterwards we

will have pie and time to visit before the school day ends. I hope you will be able to attend this performance.

The children are making great progress in all areas. They have been introduced to all the letters and sounds of the alphabet. We will continue to practice these as we learn two-letter phonograms (two letters that make one sound, such as sh, ay, ow, etc.) We are also sounding out and writing CVC words (consonant, vowel, consonant) and working on rhyming.

In math we are focusing on number sense with the GO Math program. We are learning the combinations of numbers that make the numbers up to ten, and soon to 20.

The children are so enthusiastic and excited about learning! It is such a pleasure to work with this amazing group of children.
