We've had any exciting start to the new year! This month we will have a visit from a published author who will read her book to the class and talk about writing. Our class is going to write a book on a theme chosen by the children. Each child will write and illustrate a page for the book and I will have it published through Scholastic . We will also continue to work on reading and writing with our 2nd grade buddies.

We are currently studying about Antarctica and penguins. Other social studies and science topics this semester will include presidents, animal adaptations, African animals and culture, and plants.
