1. North Fork Ambulance - Kathy Steckel, EMT/Exec. Director and Mara Derryberry, Board Member to Discuss the Special District ballot issues 7E & 7F

Establishing the North Fork Ambulance Health Service District and the taxes to fund it beginning in 2019. Annual taxes would be \$41.40 / \$100K in property value.

The all-volunteer and membership based NFA service is underfunded and in higher demand

Only 1/3 of residents in the service area pay membership dues and the costs of equipment are rising
